महाविद्यालय की सभी छात्राओं को सूचित किया जाता है कि भारत सरकार के Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education द्वारा National Scholarship Portal (NSP) के माध्यम से Academic Year 2026-27 के लिए विभिन्न छात्रवृत्ति योजनाओं के आवेदन शीघ्र प्रारम्भ किए जाने की संभावना है।

Subject: Regarding preparedness of National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for AY 2026-27.

In reference to letter no. vide no. 1-34/2020-NS.1 (pt.ii) Government of India Ministry of Education Department of Higher Education Scholarship Division, dated 19.06.2026, on the subject cited above.

I have been directed to aware you that Government of India, Ministry of Education, Department of Higher Education Scholarship Division, implements the PM-USP Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students across the nation. The Scheme is onboarded on National Scholarship Portal.

Vide OM no. D-1201101/2025-DBT dated 12.11.2025 (copy enclosed), the cabinet Secretariat has decided that, in case a student is in receipt of a Welfare Scholarship becomes eligible for a Merit Scholarship, the later shall not be denied to him as also vice-versa.

Accordingly, the National Scholarship Portal fundamental framework of "One Student One Scholarship" is being migrated to "One Student - Multiple Scholarships" from the AY 2026-27. Where, applicant would be eligible to avail one Merit-based scholarship along with multiple Welfare-based scholarships, subject to eligibility conditions. Accordingly, several modifications in the NSP workflow have been made, which are enclosed at Annexure. Keeping these changes in view, Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) have been prepared by NIC-NSP and made available in public domain on the NSP Portal for the convenience of students.

In view of above, you are requested to spread awareness about the changed modality of the National Scholarship Portal by circulating the same with the Students of your colleges and the Universities and by publishing the same on the official website of the respective Board/ Higher Education Department/ Educational Institutions so that all the stakeholders, especially eligible students are adequately informed about the revised scholarship framework and application process, thereby facilitating wider outreach, timely submission of applications, optimal utilization of scholarship opportunities, and smooth implementation of the "One Student - Multiple Scholarships" framework from AY 2026-27
